⚠ WARNINGS

Keep plastic packaging materials away from babies and children. Babies and children might put it in their mouth and suffocate!

PARKING

- The kyboka outdoor cart has no braking system. Never release you cart during a ride and when you pause. To stand still block the cart with your foot.

- Never let your cart behind unsecured. If not possible otherwise, chain it with a proper lock.

LOADING

- The maximum payload is 50kg.
- Never put sharp or edgy items in the tub. These could damage the tarpauline.
- Check if the cart is properly loaded and that all items on top are fixed and secured.

RIDING

- Before you take off check the cart if it is properly set-up. i.e. the wheel attachments, span fixtures, unstressed neck of the ring frame, solidity of the steering mechanism, grip and tire pressure.

- Avoid bumping on/off steep curves. In case you have to do it carefully.

MAINTAINING

- KYBOKA IS NOT RESISTANT TO SALT WATER.
- The Kyboka outdoor cart must be serviced regularly by its user.
- NEVER USE AGGRESSIVE CHEMICALS LIKE WHITE SPIRIT,, THINNER, ACETONE, DIESEL, CHLORINE, AMMONIA, ETC. THESE MATERIALS MAY AFFECT THE MATERIALS!
- Clean the cart every time after driving through sand, mud or squally weather with a hand brush, clean, damp cloth, soap water and/or compressed air.
- Make bearings and axles regularly clean with a brush or cloth, and maintain them on the outside with a dirt-repellent spray (teflon).
- The Kyboka outdoor cart has pneumatic tires with American /car valve.

WITH CHILDREN

- The cart is developed as an allround luggage carrier and not as a toy. Do not allow to use it as such.
- The car is not designed as a child carrier. For transporting children take sufficient precautions towards comfort and safety. We advise to use a crib/child seat.
- Don't let children tow the cart. THEY COULD USE IT IN A WRONG WAY OR CAN GET SURPRISED BY CHANGING CIRCUMSTANCES BY INCREASING FORCES AND SPEEDS WITH A RISK OF DAMAGE AND INJURIES.
- You are fully responsible for the safety of your belongings and children. IT CAN BE DANGEROUS TO LEAVE THEM UNATTENDED.

OTHER

- COMPLEMENTARY WARNINGS AND SAFETY INFORMATION WILL BE MENTIONED IN THE USER GUIDE. THESE HAVE TO BE READ ADDITIONALLY.
- Do not force when a jam occurs. Find the problem, read the manual and follow the instructions.
- The product guarantee doesn't cover any damage to the Kyboka outdoor cart and its accessoires due to wrong use or the use of non-original accessoires.

TAKE IT EASY



1

PLASTIC SLEEVE

Release all four wheels firstly. Now you can easily take the cart out of the plastic sleeve.

WHEEL OFF

1/ Stabilize the cart on the side with one hand and use the other to (de-)mount the wheels.

Keep the release button pressed in.

2/ Pull gently the wheel out of the socket.

WHEEL ON

3/ Press the button and bring the axle straight in front of the socket.

4/ Push the axle into the socket up to the end and release the button.

ATTENTION
Check always if the wheel is fixed properly by releasing the button and moving the wheel in/out. When sliding repeat step 3 and 4!

RELEASING THE STRAPS

1/ Put the cart cross in front of you.

2/ Pull the straps out of the elastic bands.

ATTENTION 1
When you don't do this the tub can't be lifted upwards at step 5!

ATTENTION 2
For the standard model, follow step 3, 5 and 6!

CLEARING THE TUB

1/ Release the buckles.

2/ Put the steering column in upward position and pivot the towing rod with handle in front of the cart.

ATTENTION
The steering column has to be fully straight upward otherwise the ringframe can not be lifted up smoothly at step 5!

REMOVING THE COVER

1/ Release the buckle at the front side

2/ Take away the cover from the tub and put it a side.

3/ Or, wrap the cover in the bungees.

RELEASING THE RING FRAME

1/ Put one hand underneath the neck at the frontside and the other on top at the rear end of the ring frame.

2/ Push the rear end downwards and release the neck such that it can slide freely upwards.

ATTENTION
For controlled lifting, always put your fingers underneath the neck and your thumb on top.

PUTTING UP THE TUB

1/ Hold the ringframe on the back and front side and guide it gently upwards along the steering column. The span mechanisms will follow automatically.

2/ Hold the slide in the upper position and push with your other hand the spans outwards into the clips.

ATTENTION
For set-up and folding, always use the grips of the span mechanisms!

OPEN RIDES

1/ Clip the bungees of the cover on the outside of the tub and wrap the straps over it.

2/ Shorten the straps and strap the buckles behind the clips on the inside of the tub and tighten them up.

3/ Insert the strap tips through the rings outside the tub.

4/ Lift up the handle and bring it in towing position.

ATTENTION
Take away the cover firstly before folding down the tub.

CLOSED RIDES

1/ Put the cover on top of the tub.

2/ Buckle up the straps and pull them tight.

3/ Insert the strap tips through the rings outside the tub.
